

## Jordan Insurance Federation joins International Union of Marine Insurance



Jordan Daily – The Jordan Insurance Federation (JIF), the professional entity for the insurance sector in Jordan, has become an associate member of the International Union of Marine Insurance (IUMI), the global association for marine and transport insurers.

JIF was established in 1989 by a Royal Decree and represents 22 insurance companies in Jordan, offering a variety of services including marine insurance, motor insurance, fire and earthquake insurance, life and medical insurance, and takaful insurance.
